<b>Delivery/Presentation (35%)</b>	Speaker maintains good eye contact with the audience and is appropriately animated (e.g. gestures, moving around, etc.)	5
	Speaker uses clear/audible voice	5
	Visual aids (video is allowed) are well-prepared, informative, effective, not distracting.	10
	Length of presentation is within the assigned time	5
	Information was well communicated	10
